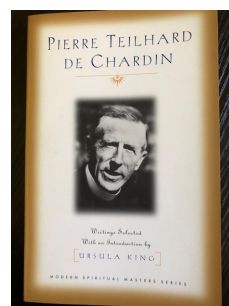
SEPTEMBER 16 — DEADLINE FOR SUPPER CLUBS

Tielhard de Chardin (1881-1955) was a French Jesuit theologian and scientist known for his pioneering field work in paleontology. His visionary writings on faith and evolutionary theory aroused suspicion of the Vatican and he was forbidden to publish on religious matters in his lifetime.
