# THE NICENE CREED

#### Presiding Priest and People

Remembering now his work of redemption, and offering to you this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, We celebrate his death and resurrection, as we await the day of his coming.

Lord God of our Fathers: God of Abraham and Sarah, Isaac and Rebekah, Jacob, Rachel and Leah; God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ: Open our eyes to see your hand at work in the world about us.
