GLUTEN FREE EUCHARISTIC HOSTS are available for those who need them. Please ask the priest at communion.

SUNDAY SCHOOL FOR CHILDREN AGES 1-11 is offered at 9:45am each Sunday in the Room with a View (ask an usher for directions). St. Barnabas uses the Godly Play curriculum, which involves prayer, Bible stories, lessons, worship and art responses to the stories. Drop-off is at the classroom, and teachers bring the children in to church during announcements, so families can enjoy communion together. WE WELCOME ALL CHILDREN IN CHURCH, and we expect them to be children! We also know that sometimes parents become uncomfortable with extreme wiggles, giggles, howls or hollers. We stream live audio from the church into the Parlor, so you won't miss a thing. You'll also find a nursery at the end of the hallway, where there are rocking chairs and lots of amusement for little ones.

“ENGAGING THE MYSTERIES OF HOLY WEEK”:

2018 LENTEN SERIES: WEDNESDAYS THROUGH MARCH 21

What really happened for Jesus and his companions in that last, holy week of his life? Join us for our Wednesday evening Lenten series as we explore the mysterious happenings of those last days. We'll consider the exhilaration of the Palm Sunday procession, Judas' heady and emotional betrayal of Jesus, Jesus' humility, courage and tenderness as he washed his friend's feet. We'll sit at the foot of the cross, wait at the tomb and arrive at the resurrection and find ourselves re-created as Easter people.

In this five-week series entitled “Engaging the Mysteries of Holy Week,” we'll explore some of the hidden meanings of this most sacred of all weeks in the Christian year. Led by St Barnabas clergy, the series continues for five consecutive Wednesday evenings (through March 21). We gather at 6pm for a simple supper, followed by a presentation and conversation, and will finish by 8pm. Invite your friends and neighbors to join us as we deepen our preparation for Holy Week and engage the dilemmas, fears, questions, hopes and opportunities for transformation that arise from the journey Jesus and his disciples took in those final days in Jerusalem.
