The Women's Schola Nova Choir of Bainbridge Island will sing the Office of Evensong on Sunday, January 13th at 6pm.

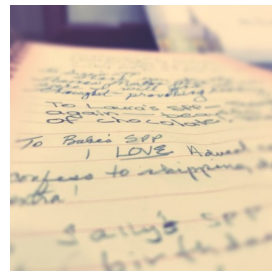
### THANK YOU FROM THE OUTREACH COMMITTEE
