## BABY QUILTS FOR MONGOLIAN NEWBORNS

Please join us for a sew-in day on Thursday 25th April in the Parish Hall from 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. Our 17 quilt completed quilt tops have now been machine quilted by Wanda Rains and are ready to be finished by adding binding. This requires hand-sewing a blind or hemming stitch and no quilting expertise is needed. Drop in for a couple of hours, or stay longer and bring a sack lunch. If you are unable to come to the sew-in but would like to hand-sew a quilt binding, please contact Maggie, ([maggie.quilter@gmail.com](mailto:maggie.quilter@gmail.com), (206) 714-4789). Local quilters have already completed 35 quilts and we anticipate having at least 50 ready to be blessed at our Sunday services on 28th April. The quilts will then be packed in boxes to be shipped to Mongolia in a container in early May. They will be displayed at the quilt show in Ulaanbaatar and then distributed to newborns in rural Mongolia. ## BISHOP RICKEL WILL BE WITH US IN JUNE!



Be sure to mark your calendars for Sunday June 16<sup>th</sup> and join us for Bishop Rickel's visitation! The Bishop is with us only once every three years and we know you won't want to miss him. In addition to hearing him preach, one of the most special things about the Bishop's visitation is the opportunity to be Baptized, Confirmed or Received into the Episcopal Church right here at St Barnabas.

Bishop Rickel stands in the apostolic succession that began with Jesus laying hands on Peter who laid hands on others and made them bishops, who laid hands on others and made them bishops and so on throughout time. Bishops are the successors to the apostles whose authority is derived by an unbroken succession in the ministry and laying on of hands. Having the opportunity to have those hands laid on you in Baptism, Confirmation or Reception is a gift we hope you will accept.

If you are a baptized person who has been confirmed in the Catholic or Lutheran Church, you may be Received in the Episcopal Church. Others may be Baptized or Confirmed. Preparation for Confirmation, Reception and Adult Baptism will be held on Sundays in May at 1PM. Children's baptism preparation happens apart from this series.
